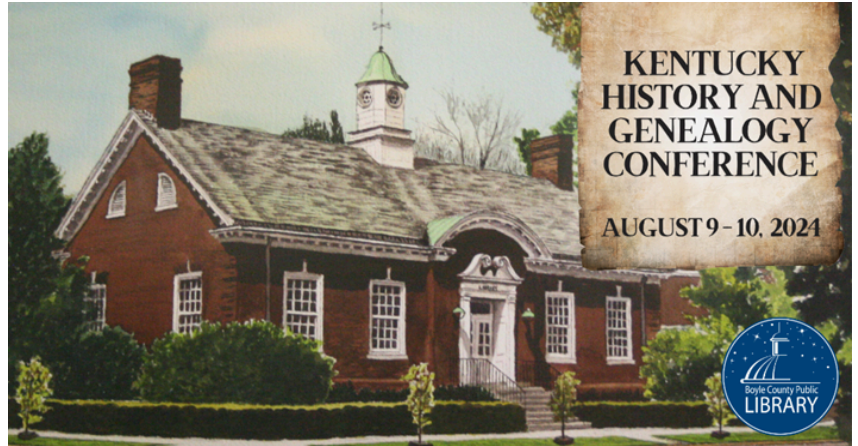


Hello

General Conference Information

The conference sessions will run from 10:00 a.m. to 5:15 p.m. with a break for lunch from 12:15 p.m.- 1:45 p.m. both Friday and Saturday, but our doors will open to conference attendees at 9:30 a.m. We ask that you arrive with enough time to register and pick up your conference supplies in our lobby. We will also provide water, coffee, and light breakfast fare.

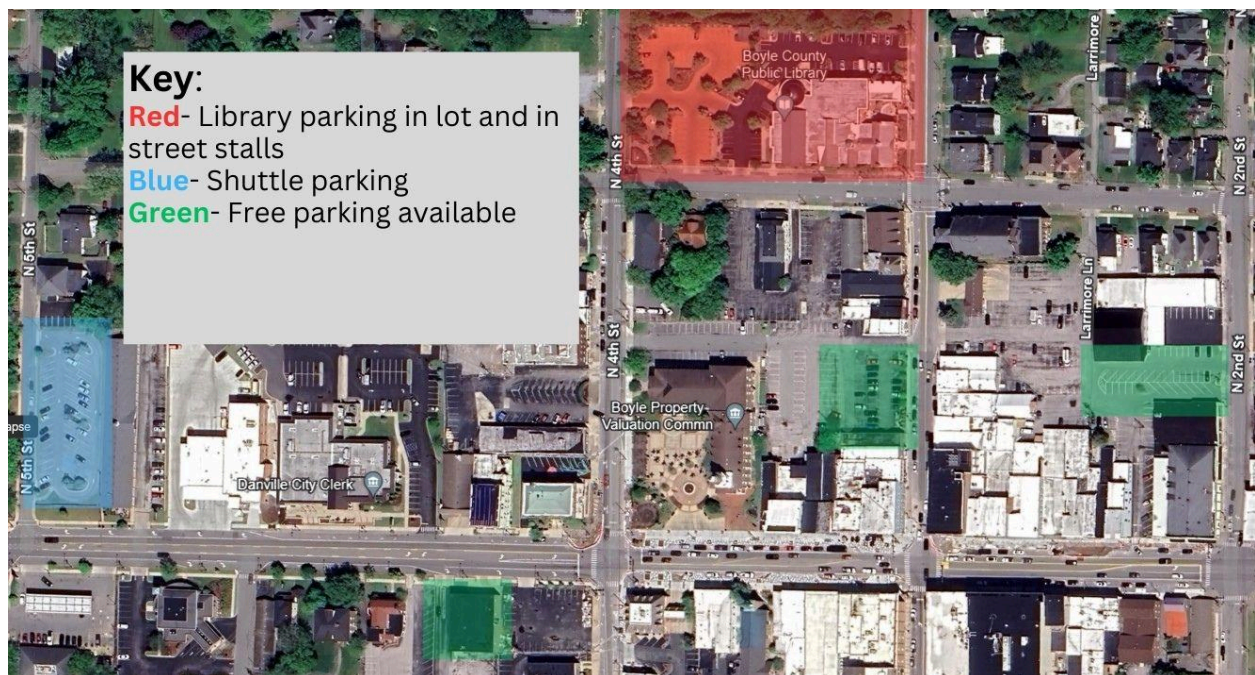
The Boyle County Public Library has five levels, each accessible via an elevator in the center of the building or stairs in the front and back of the lobby. The conference presentations will be taking place on the **first level** in the **Community Room** and **Conference Room**, on the **fourth level** in the **Reading Room**, and on the **fifth level** in the **Adult Nonfiction** section. A map of the library will be provided in the conference brochure available during the event. All areas of the library are accessible, but if you have any questions or concerns please contact the library prior to the event.

Parking

The library has a parking lot directly in front of the building and street parking along the building on Broadway St., 3rd St., and 4th St. The Stith Funeral Home on Broadway St. may make its parking lot available to attendees, but if their building is needed for a funeral, conference attendees will not be able to use it.

Additionally, there are 19 free parking spaces in the 3rd Street permit lot and 4 spaces in the 2nd Street permit lot. There's also a free surface lot on Main Street, across from Danville Bike and Footwear, which can accommodate 40-50 vehicles.

Centre has generously allowed the library to use one of their parking lots during the duration of the conference. It is .3 miles away from the library, but we will have a shuttle running from the parking lot to the library during registration, lunch, and closing.



Other Weekend and Upcoming Events

There are several other events happening in Danville and Boyle County the same weekend as the conference, and we encourage attendees to stay and enjoy the other activities in town!

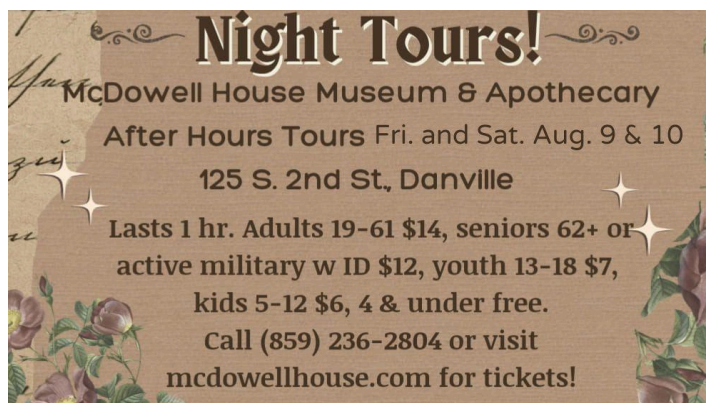
