Practice your skills, share your work, and receive feedback from peers. Facilitated by author Paul Stansbury.

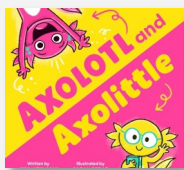

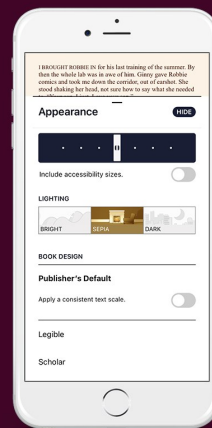
BCPL Hometown Hub Perryville & Junction City
