Let reading color your world this summer as you take part in Summer Reading 2025 at the Boyle County Public Library!

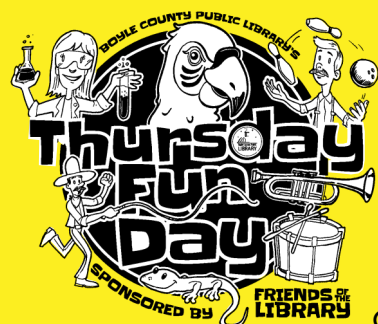
