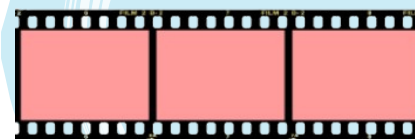

## WHERE IT IS



The Memory Lab can be found on the 5th level of the Library, inside of the Computer Lab. It is a private cubicle containing all of the equipment you would need for digitizing your histories.

## WHAT IT SUPPORTS



The Memory Lab can currently support and convert the following formats into digital: VHS, cassette tapes, 8mm film, Super 8 film, vinyl records, photographs, negatives, and slides.
